Assignment of Street Name – "'Ike 'Onipa'a Road" 'Ōla'a Reservation Lots, Puna, Island of Hawai'i TMK: (3)1-7-013:016

This is in response to your letter received by our office on July 11, 2011, requesting the naming of a roadway off of Enos Road, 'Ōla'a Reservation Lots, Puna, Hawai'i. Therefore, in accordance with Ordinance 04-82, Chapter 14, Article 14, Street Addressing and Naming, we have named the roadway as follows:

'Ike 'Onipa'a Road - the calm within the chaos.

We have determined that your proposed street name is acceptable, and 'Ike 'Onipa'a Road has been reserved for naming the above referenced roadway. Our records show that the roadway in this subdivision is a government roadway. You will be responsible to install a street sign to identify this roadway. See attached guidelines on the placement of the street sign. If additional information is needed, please consult the Department of Public Works, Traffic Division at 961-8341.

For the your information, the United States Postal Service (USPS) has informed this office of new mail delivery guidelines, which encourages the use of centralized mail delivery equipment. We have enclosed a flyer provided by the USPS. If you and other landowners situated along these newly named roadways are contemplating mail delivery, we encourage you to contact the local USPS Growth Coordinator at (808) 423-3908.

This is in response to your January 17, 2008 transmittal requesting Ron Matsumura's review of documents from Mr. Roy Nakamoto's office.

The 1915 Hawaii Territory Survey homestead map of "Olaa Reservation Lots, 11 to 17 miles" does not show a road between Grant 4255 and Grant 4772 (see attached).

However, Ron Matsumura does concur with Mr. Nakamoto that there is a government road right-of-way (or road reserve) between those grants as called for in their respective metes and bounds descriptions in the Land Patents from the Republic of Hawaii (Grant 4255), and the Territory of Hawaii (Grant 4772).

The approximate location of the road is highlighted on the attached USGS map. Only an actual ground survey would reveal if the highlighted road is within the 20 foot right-of-way. If so, then it could be a "Road-in-Limbo." We do not intend to conduct such a survey. Please note that although it is a government right-of-way, the Department of Public Works does not maintain it.
