This letter is in regards to the Survey taken on March 14, 2025 by dlb & Associates with respect to my concern of an Albezia tree situated on Hawaii County roadside property as verified by the dlb & Associate's Survey (attached).

The canopy extends into my property and has posed safety issues for my visitors with children, my gardener/Landscaper and contractors. Also, being new to the Big Island and hearing that Albezia trees are weak, the thought of a storm blowing it down towards my home is feared. Since the purchase of my property, approaching two years, I have observed the tree's growth of at least 20 feet higher. Attached are photos of the tree and branches that fall daily on to my property.

The County Road Manager for the crew that works on the Piha Kahuku Roadway area has already been notified of my concerns. However, no documents have been provided to me indicating differences of opinions as to my boundary line of which as explained by owner Daniel L. Berg, PLS11245 dlb & Associates, is quite clear the tree is not on my property. I am requesting the removal of the tree as it poses a serious, dangerous and hazardous condition during high winds and storms.

It would be greatly appreciated the tree be removed, not only for my own concerns but also for the safety of the many residents that live above me, who drive the Piha Kahuku Road daily to and from work, which is a potential hazardous condition and liability pending to happen.
