ROYAL PATENT.

KAMEHAMEHA III, By the grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this His Royal Patent, makes known unto all men, that he has for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given, absolutely, in Fee Simple unto Francis Davis his faithful and loyally disposed subject for the consideration of Forty Nine Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situated at Kainehe

Hama Kua in the Island of Hawaii, and described as follows:

Beginning at a Kuru tree at the S.E. angle of a Kuleana adjoining said lot on the North, and running along this Kuleana N 78° W. 580 feet to the middle of the Ravine bounding Kainehe on the West, thence up the middle of said Ravine along Kahi Lalele, as follows; S. 33° 30' E. 680 feet; S. 15° E. 253 feet; S. 25° 20' E. 192 feet; S. 63° E. 360 feet; S. 47° 15' W. 312 feet; S. 10° E. 325 feet; S. 42° E. 272 feet; S. 82° 25' 22' 30' W. 262 feet, to the boundary of this lot, thence S. 23° 15' E. 720 feet across to the middle of the Ravine separating Kainehe from Kuraia, thence down the middle of that Ravine, to the N.E. angle of this lot, thence S. 23° 15' W. 700 feet to the place of beginning

Containing 49 Acres, more or less:
excepting and reserving to the Hawaiian Government, all mineral or metallic Mines of every description.

To have and to hold the above granted Land in Fee Simple, unto the said *Francis Davis*, his Heirs and Assigns forever, subject to the taxes to be from time to time imposed by the Legislative Council equally, upon all landed Property held in Fee Simple.
