

Notes of Survey of Kahoa (North) in Hilo,  
Hawaii for John Ely.

Commencing at stake at Makai East boundary of this land,  
joining Middle Kahoa just makai of Jno. Ely's dwelling house and  
running

North 52° 45' West	10	680	chains	20 feet along makai side of this land to middle of stream separating this from land called Makea; then from point of conn't. and running
South 45° 30' West	5	330	chains	to Lauhala in pa puua on south edge of Coffee Plantation; thence
South 43° 45' West	6	437.6	chains	41-7/12 feet to angle of Ki fence; thence
South 35° West	11	752.5	chains	26-4/12 feet to Lauhala marked A on right edge of path; thence
South 36° 45' West	5	340	chains	10 feet to point by path; thence
South 63° West	2	158.45	chains	26-4/12 feet to main Road, point where water run crosses it; thence
South 55° West	18-3/4		chains	to stake on South top of pali of Waihapupu ravine;
South 43° 45' West	13-1/2		chains	to stake in path (crossing this land on to Kaupokuea) on top South pali of Waihapupu ravine; thence
South 72° 45' West	10		chains	to stake on South top of pali of Waihapupu; thence
South 56° 30' West	19-3/4		chains	to stake on right edge of foot path (leading up to woods) near Lauhala; thence
South 45° West	4		chains	13 <sup>2</sup> / <sub>12</sub> feet to stake by foot path on top of ridge on left & mauka side of cultivated neneleau; thence
South 58° 45' West	36		chains	along ridge near foot path to stake at south mauka corner of this land, at head of little ravine running into Kaupokuea Stream; thence

kui tree marked B on North  
edge of stream separating this
