ROYAL PATENT.

KAMEHAMEHA IV., By the grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this His Royal Patent, makes known unto all men, that he has, for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given, absolutely, in Fee Simple, unto *C. R. Macomber* his faithful and loyally disposed subject, for the consideration of *One Hundred & ten Dollars*

Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situated at *Kau* in the Island of *Hawaii* and described as follows:

Commencing at an old stone wall below the Kaaluanu Road & running along the boundary of Waioiao -

*L.R. Macomber*, his Heirs and Assigns forever, subject to the taxes to be from time to  
time imposed by the Legislative Council equally, upon all landed Property held in Fee Simple.

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my Hand, and caused the Great Seal of the  
Hawaiian Islands to be affixed, at Honolulu, this

19 day of *September* 1862
