ROYAL PATENT.

KAMEHAMEHA IV., By the grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this His Royal Patent, makes known unto all men, that he has, for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given, absolutely, in Fee Simple, unto C. R. Macomber his faithful and loyally disposed subject, for the consideration of One Hundred & Ten Dollars paid into the

Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situated at  
Kaneohe in the Island of

Palaau Valley

and described as follows:

(commencing at an old stone wall below the Kaualau Road & running along the boundary of Maionao -

To have and to hold the above granted Land in Fee Simple, unto the said

C. R. Macomber, his Heirs and Assigns forever, subject to the taxes to be from time to time imposed by the Legislative Council equally, upon all landed Property held in Fee Simple.

Hawaiian Islands to be affixed, at Honolulu, this

19 day of September 1862
