

Freitas husband To Jose Medeiros  
1892 Deed.

Know all men by these presents, that I, Mrs. Maria Teresa de Freitas, Manuel de Freitas, my husband, of Honohaa, Oahu, Hawaii, in consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00), to me paid by Jose Medeiros of said Honohaa, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Jose Medeiros, his heirs and assigns, of my right, title and estate in and to those premises situate in Honolulu, in said island, as described in Land Patent No. 3304, inherited by me from my father, Mello, and containing 1 7/800 Acres.

I have and to hold the same unto him with all the right easements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto in anywise appertaining unto the said Jose Medeiros, and his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever. In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our hands and seals, this 14th day of March, A. D. 1900.

1892 Release of Deed.
