Beginning at the east corner of Lot 33 and north corner of Lot 32, at an ohia post, on side road, and running:

- N. 80° 00' W. true 1452 feet along side road to ohia post;
- S. 60° 00' W. " 3000 " " Lots 32 & 39, to ohia post;
- S. 30° 00' E " 1452 feet along side road, to ohia post;
- N. 60° 00' E " 3000 " " Lots 41 & 32 to the point of beginning.




