By this its Patent the Government of the Republic of Hawaii makes known to all men that it has this day granted and given unto

Manuel Fricas

for the consideration of One hundred and sixty six $\frac{5}{10}$ (\$166 $\frac{5}{10}$) Dollars paid into the Exchequer, and for the further consideration of his having complied with the terms and conditions of the Homestead Act, of 1890.



2. S. 42° 20' W. 169 " bottom of Gulch;
3. S. 62° 40' W. 170 " " " ;
4. S. 35° 05' W. 219 " " " ;
5. S. 74° 30' W. 1613 " Lot 6 to so ft road;
6. N. 24° 10' W. 820 " so ft road to point of beginning and containing an area of 2.2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres.

To have and to hold the above Granted Land in Fee Simple until the
said Manuel Freites his heirs and assigns forever.
