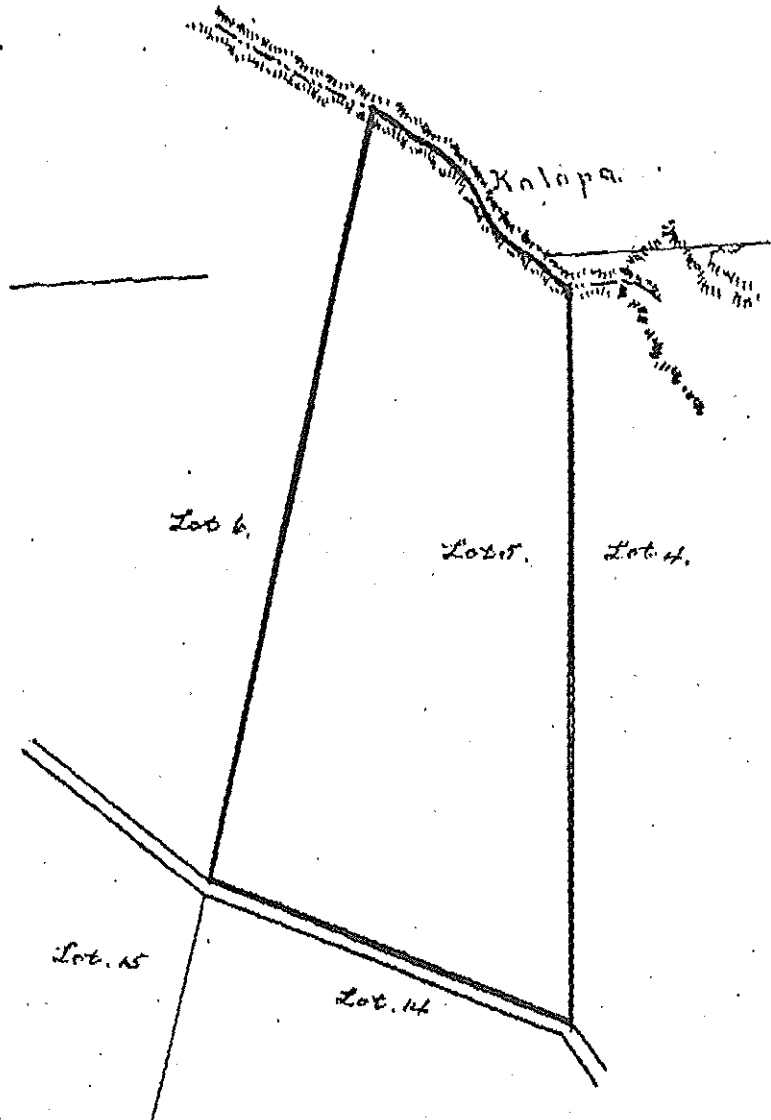

and described as follows:

Lot No 5 Map 2

Beginning at the south corner of Lot 4, at 30 ft road, this point being S. 89 $^{\circ}$ 13' W. 430 ft approx at Kalanikai station, thence running by true bearings:

1. N. 87 $^{\circ}$ 50' W. 1505 ft. along Lot 4 to middle of Gulch;
 2. S. 42 $^{\circ}$ 20' W. 169 " " bottom of Gulch;
