for the consideration of Four Hundred and Thirty Nine ^{00/100} Dollars paid into the Cashier, and for the further consideration of her having complied with the terms and conditions of Part 14 of the Land Act of 1894, necessary for the purchase of additional land.

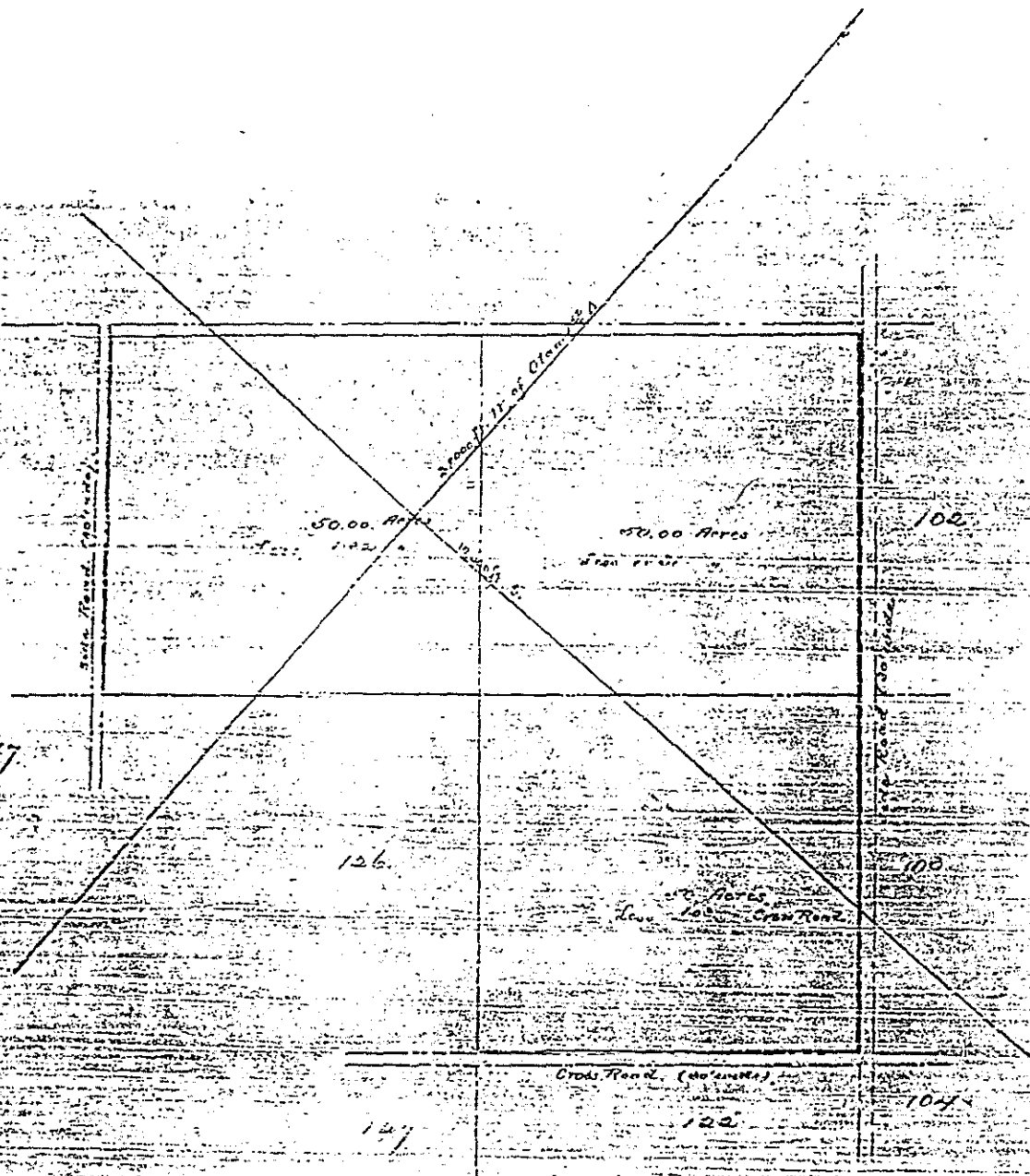
all that piece of land situate at Olua in the District of Tunahi Island of Hawaii and described as follows:

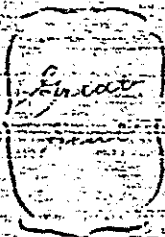
