having complied with the terms and conditions of the
Homestead Act of 1892.

mines of every description.

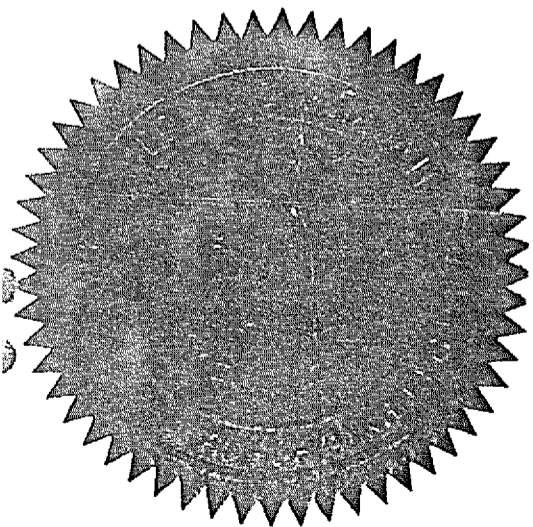
To have and to hold the above Granted Land in Fee Simple unto the
said Jose Ferreira his heirs and assigns for ever.

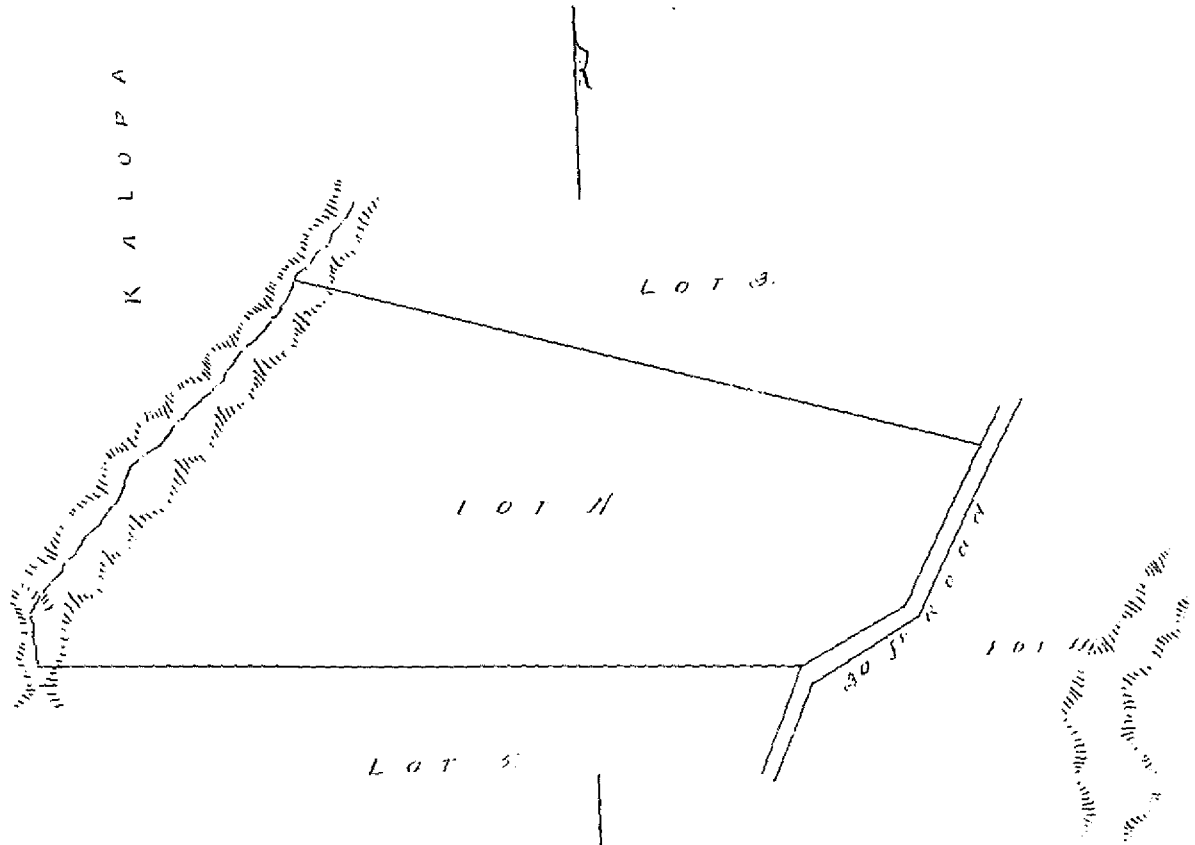
