

Beginning at an ohia tree marked □ at the foot of which is set a 1/2" wrought iron tube, said ohia being S. 42° 52' W. "true" 3032 feet from the Hawaii Govt. Survey Reference point, "Weloeka" the boundary runs by true bearings.

1. S. 80° 26' E. 127 ft. down bank of Kealaau stream to middle of same.
2. S. 52° 54' W. 2510 ft. along middle of Kealaau stream to □ marked on rock in same.
3. N. 57° 59' W. 1170 ft. along Govt. forest remainder.
4. N. 62° 22' W. 385 ft. along same to post marked 2. set in at East edge of road.
5. N. 53° 47' E. 2395 ft. along East edge of road 110 ft. wide separating this section from section 3.

6. S. 63° 02' E. 1451 ft. along lower edge of woods to the point of beginning containing an area of 78.7 acres.
