Geo H. Angus



all that piece of land situate at Kaiuilaahilahi in the District of Märthi Hilo — Island of Hawaii — and described as follows:

Section No. 5.

Beginning at a marked point in middle of Ahoa stream, the same being the west angle of Section 4, the boundary runs by true bearings.

1. N. 45° 55' E. 2264 ft. along middle of Ahoa stream to East angle.
2. S. 61° 29' W. 2232 ft. along bank of Ahoa stream and along lower edge of forest to N. angle in Kaiuilaahilahi stream.
3. S. 25° 45' W. 935 ft. along middle of said stream to top of falls.
4. S. 51° 19' W. 1150 ft. along same to marked in middle.
5. S. 56° 31' E. 1958 ft. along Sout forest remainder to the point of beginning. Containing an area of 95.7 acres.

Excepting and reserving to the Hawaiian Government all mineral or metallic
mines of every description.

To have and to hold the above Granted Land in Fee Simple unto the
said Geo H Angus his heirs and assigns for ever.
