

all that piece of land situate at Papaaloa in the District of North Kilo Island of Hawaii and described as follows:

Lot No. 7

Beginning at a post marked VII standing 40 feet distant and bearing  $92^{\circ} 65' 25''$  W. "true" from the ohia tree marked at the foot of which is set a 12" wrought iron tube, the co-ordinates of said ohia tree referred to the Hawaii Gov't. Survey & 1st Sta. "Papaaloa" being South 3898 ft. West 4057 ft.) the boundary runs by true bearings:

1.  $92^{\circ} 65' 25''$  W. 955 ft. along lower edge of forest to post at North angle.
2. S.  $25^{\circ} 27'$  W. 1990 ft. along Section #8 to west angle at ohia tree.
3. S.  $70^{\circ} 55'$  E. 581 ft. along Gov't forest remainder.
4. S.  $60^{\circ} 27'$  E. 1225 ft. along same to post marked V1 at South angle.
5.  $92^{\circ} 41' 10''$  E. 425 ft. along west edge of road 40ft. wide separating this lot from section #6.
6.  $92^{\circ} 31' 30''$  W. 360 ft. along road as aforesaid.
7.  $92^{\circ} 9' 16''$  W. 720 ft. along road as aforesaid.
8.  $92^{\circ} 8' 32''$  E. 872 ft. along road as aforesaid to the point of beginning. Containing an area of 62.4 acres.
