for the consideration of Two Hundred and Fifty One (\$251.00) Dollars paid into the Exchequer, and for the further consideration of his having complied with the terms and conditions in Agreement of Sale dated July 25<sup>th</sup> 1895.


all that piece of land situate at Kapehu 2 in the District of North Hilo Island of Hawaii and described as follows:

Beginning at the North angle, at pool below falls in the Pahale stream, said point bearing S 63° 02' 0" true distance 880 ft. from the obelisk and 12" iron tube known as the Hawaiian Govt. Survey Reference Point "Moanahuluwaka" the boundary runs by five bearings:


1. S. 63° 02' 0" 1677 ft. along lower edge of woods to post marked III at West edge of roadway,
2. S. 53° 47' 14" 2390 ft. along West edge of roadway 40 ft. wide, separating this section from section # 2, to post marked III. at South angle,
3. N. 62° 22' 14" 899 ft. along Govt. forest remainder to III marked on rock in middle Pahale stream,
4. N. 34° 50' 0" 2165 ft. along middle of Pahale stream to falls and down the same to Point of Beginning

mines of every description.


To have and to hold the above Granted Land in Fee Simple unto the
