By this Patent the Governor of the Territory of Hawaii, in conformity with the laws of the United States of America and of the Territory of Hawaii, makes known to all men that he has this day granted and confirmed unto

Andrew Gardin

for the consideration of one Hundred and Seventy-Six Dollars, \$ 176⁷⁰/₁₀₀ paid into the Treasury.

And for the further consideration of his having complied with the terms and conditions of the Homestead Act.

all of the land situate at Waipunalai
in the District of Aiea Island of Hawaii bounded and described as follows:

Lot No. 18 Homestead Map No 16

Beginning at North E. of this Lot being S. E. & W. E. of Lots 14, 17, and 15 respectively 796 ft. S. 942 ft. W. of concrete reference block at S E. of Lot 4, and running as follows:—
