# Land Patent No. 11696

(Grant)

On Right of Purchase Lease under Part VII of the Land Act of 1895

By this Patent the Governor of the Territory of Hawaii, in conformity with the laws of the United States of America and of the Territory of Hawaii, makes known to all men that he has this day granted and confirmed unto

Samuel Koolohoe

for the consideration of Three hundred & Thirty two Dollars, \$ 332 98  
paid into the Treasury.

And for the further consideration of his having  
complied with the terms and conditions of Part VII  
of the Land Act of 1895.

all of the land situated at Kahuku  
in the District of Kilo, Island of Hawaii, bounded  
and described as follows:

Right of Purchase Lease No. 173

Lots Nos. 11 & 12, Homestead Map No. 10, First Land District.


Lot No. 11. Beginning at a point on south side of road 40 ft.  
wide, being west L of Lot 10, 2302 ft. South 399 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. West of Kahuku  
Trig. Station, and running as follows:-

1. S.  $36^{\circ} 15'$  W. true 586 ft. along road the line of road being the boundary;
2. S.  $44^{\circ} 30'$  E. " 1433 " " Lot 12;
3. N.  $41^{\circ} 5'$  E. " 582 " " Kanue, the middle of Waiehu Gulch  
being the boundary;
4. N.  $44^{\circ} 45'$  W. " 1505 " " Lot 10, to initial point, and containing  
an area of 19.84 Acres.

Lot No. 12. Beginning at a point on south side of road 30 ft.  
wide being West L of Lot 11, 44337 ft. West 2768 ft. South of Kahuku  
Trig. Station and running as follows:-

1. S.  $35^{\circ} 30'$  W. true 85 ft. across the lot the line of road

Sect A.  $32^{\circ} 15' E.$  true 573 ft. along Name, the middle of Waichus Gilch  
H. N.  $44^{\circ} 30' W.$  "  $1435^{\circ}$  " <sup>bring the boundary;</sup>
