By this Patent the Governor of the Territory of Hawaii, in conformity with the laws of the United States of America and of the Territory of Hawaii, makes known to all men that he has this day granted and confirmed unto

I S A B E L M A R Q U E S


for the consideration of Two Hundred 00/100 Dollars, \$ 200-00/100 paid into the Treasury.

And for the further consideration of his having complied with the terms and conditions of the Homestead Act of 1892

all of the land situated at KAAPAHU
in the District of HAMAKUA Island of HAWAII bounded
and described as follows:

Lot No. 2, Homestead Map No. 3, Second Land District

Beginsing at South corner of Lot 1, at 30 ft. road this point being S 1779' foot E, 543 ft. approx. from Kalonai Station, thence running by true bearings:-
1- S 86° 00' W 1018 feet along Lot 1 to middle of Gulch;
2- S 00° 50' W 202 feet along bottom of gulch;
3- S 27° 40' E 118 feet along bottom of gulch;
4- S 08° 25' W 280 feet along bottom of gulch;
5- S 48° 40' W 180 feet along bottom of gulch;
6- S 67° 25' E 900 feet along Lot 3 to 30 ft. road;
7- N 22° 20' E 368 feet along 30 ft. road;
8- N 04° 10' E 337 feet along 30 ft. road;
9- N 19° 25' E 440 feet along 30 ft. road to point of beginning and containing an area of 20 acres.
