Lot 22.

Beginning at a post marking the North angle of this lot, at the South edge of 100 foot width Forest Reserve, the coordinates of said point referred to the Government Survey Trig Station "Kauku" being 1981.4 feet North and 1756.8 feet West as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2296, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $47^{\circ} 10'$  958.0 feet along South edge of 100 foot width Forest Reserve along top of pali of Kaholono gulch;
2.  $333^{\circ} 05'$  560.0 feet along Honomu remainder;
3.  $334^{\circ} 56'$  99.1 feet along same;
4.  $260^{\circ} 26'$  675.1 feet along North edge of 56 foot roadway;
5.  $268^{\circ} 05'$  635.0 feet along same;
6.  $263^{\circ} 20'$  610.8 feet along same;
7.  $124^{\circ} 38'$  1823.0 feet along Lot 21 to point of beginning.
