Subject, however, to the conditions continued in Section 73 of the Act of April 30, 1900 to pr vide a government for the Territory of Hawaii as amended, commonly known as the Organ Act, and more particularly of that portion thereof which reads as follows:
"No land for which any such certificate (of occupation), (right of purchase) lease, or (an freehold agreement or special homestead) agreement shall hereafter be issued, or any pathereof or interest therein or control thereof shall, without the written consent of the commit sioner and governor, thereafter, whether before or after a homestead lease or patent has be issued thereon, be or be contracted to be in any way, directly or indirectly, by process of law atherwise, conveyed, mortgaged, lease or otherwise transferred to or acquired or held by or f the benefit of any alien or corporation; or, before or after the issuance of a homestead lease before the issuance of a patent, to or by or for the benefit of any other person; or, after t issuance of a patent, to or by or for the benefit of any person who owns, holds, or control directly or indirectly, other land or the use thereof the combined area of which and the land question exceeds eighty acres: Provided, That these prohibitions shall not apply to transfe or acquisitions by inheritance or between tenants in common. Any land in respect of which any of the foregoing provisions shall be violated shall forthwith be forfeited and resume to status of public land and may be recovered by the Territory or its successors in an action ejectment or other appropriate proceedings."
