ROYAL PATENT.

Under an Act "To Authorize the Issuance of Royal Patents for School Lands and School Sites, sold by the Board of Education."

Whereas, Under and by virtue of an Act of the Legislative Assembly of the Hawaiian Kingdom, approved on the 13th day of August, in the Year of our Lord 1880, and entitled "An Act to Authorize the Issuance of ROYAL PATENTS for School Lands and School Sites, sold by the Board of Education," the Board of Education has made a requisition to the Minister of the Interior for the issuance to the said Board of a ROYAL PATENT for the Lands hereinafter described, being School Lands or School Sites :

Therefore, **KALAKUA**, by the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this ROYAL PATENT, makes known to all men, that under and by virtue of the provisions of the said recited Act, He has for Himself and His successors in office, this day granted and given absolutely in Fee Simple, unto

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS,

all that certain piece of Land situate at *Hele*
