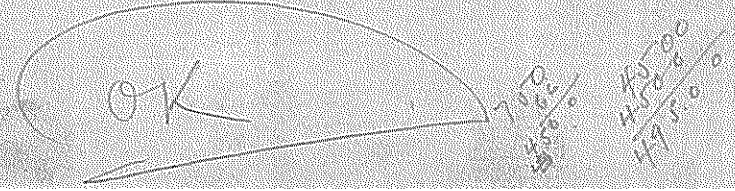

South 57 1/2 East 16.60 Chains to the land of Kai, then along his boundary

South 61 1/2 West 20.10 chains, to the point of commencement, and this piece of land there

is 22 1/100 Acres, more or less, and that is a certain portion of the land which was

deeded to me by Alohikea and Kan, the wife of Napua, deceased, from that joint land as

described in Royal Patent (Grant) Number 919 to Puaa, Napua and Alohikea, and that deed

is recorded in Book 16, pages 387 & 388.
