**DESCRIPTION**

PORTIONS OF GRANT 252, TO B. PITMAN; OF R.P. 5738, L.C.Aw. 1108, TO LUMAINA; AND OF THE LAND GRANTED TO THE HILO BOARDING SCHOOL BY THE TERRITORY OF HAWAII, BY DEED DATED MAY 23, 1921, ALL IN THE LAND OF PONAHAUAI, SOUTH HILO DISTRICT, ISLAND AND TERRITORY OF HAWAII.

Beginning at a spike set in concrete on the northeast corner of this piece of land, and on the West side of Kapiolani Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to the Government Survey Triangulation Station HALAL, being 1266.80 feet North, and 2639.63 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South, as follows:

1. 40° 44' 214.18 feet, along the Seventh-Day Adventist Church and Mission Lot, to an iron bolt set in concrete;
2. 332° 01' 357.75 feet, along same, and along Takaichi Fujikawa's Lot, to the Northwest side of Ponahawai Street;
3. 52° 30' 531.43 feet, along the Northwest side of Ponahawai Street extension;
4. 152° 30' 301.10 feet, along remainder of Grant 252, to B. Pitman, owned by the Hilo Sugar Co., to a 2" pipe set in concrete;
5. 234° 28' 80.75 feet, along the Hilo Boarding School Lot, to a pipe;
6. 220° 52' 208.39 feet, along remainder of the Hilo Boarding School Lot, to a X on rock;
7. 326° 42' 34.47 feet, along Road Reserve, to a pipe;
8. 221° 05' 138.00 feet, along same, to a pipe;
9. 161° 45' 21.77 feet, along same, to a spike;
10. 156° 51' 30" 16.69 feet, along same, to a pipe;
11. 220° 52' 327.91 feet, along remainder of R.P. 5738, L.C. Award 1108, to Lumaina, owned by the John li Estate Ltd., to a pipe set in concrete on the West side of Kapiolani Street;
12. 325° 53' 35.12 feet, along the West side of Kapiolani Street, to the point of beginning, and containing an area of 179,770. Square Feet, or 4.127 Acres.

A single burial plot is designated a BURIAL, indicated by a small figure.

A group of BURIALS is designated a LOT, indicated by a larger figure.

A group of LOTS is designated a ROW, indicated by a capital letter.
