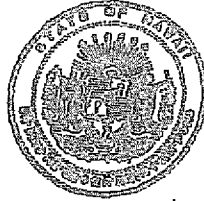

ROYAL PATENT.

Upon Confirmation by the Land Commission.

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners to quiet Land Titles have by their decision awarded unto

M. Kekauonohi *J. Olowai* d. 112/16
Ap 4/2

an estate of **Freehold** less than Alodial, in and to the Land hereafter described, and whereas

Chas. Spreckles the present Owner of the within described land has applied to the Minister of the Interior for a Royal Patent on the same a Certificate of the Boundaries being filed and the Government Conveyance having been relinquished by a Resolution of the High Council during the reign of Kamehameha III.

THEREFORE, by the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands, by this Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he has, for himself and his successors in office, this day granted and given absolutely, in Fee Simple, unto

M. Kekauonohi
as the Ahupuaa of Kihalaumu
in the Island of *Hawaii* and described as follows:

Beginning at a rock set in ground on top of bluff at sea level on the boundary of Kihalaumu the point Kaunakakai Chimney S 55° 15' E true course 1145 feet S 55° 15' true course 1575 feet thence the boundary follows the shore at foot of bluff the boundary along top of bluff being as follows N 17° 39' W true 291 feet along top of bluff N 22° 26' E true 211 feet along top of bluff N 52° 50' W true 378 feet along top of bluff N 23° 58' W true 114 feet along top of bluff N 20° 07' W true 204 feet along top of bluff N 41° 03' W true along top of bluff 133 feet N 56° 16' W true 111 feet along top of bluff S 89° 07' W true 162 feet along top of bluff N 82° 07' W true 150 feet along top of bluff N 42° 20' W true 471 feet along top of bluff S 40° 25' W true 257 feet along top of bluff S 63° 17' W true 571 feet along top of bluff 704 feet ascending into Kihalaumu gulch to a rock marked K. on the side of Kihalaumu stream, S 30° 09' W 274 feet along north bank of stream. Thence along the side or edge of Kihalaumu stream to a point bearing S 66° 16' W distant 890 feet. Thence still along the side of Kihalaumu stream to point near mouth of Maawaa gulch, which point bears S 51° 15' W distant 880 feet from last mentioned point. Thence along the side of Maawaa stream to junction of Maawaa and Mailelele stream, which point bears S 45° 16' W distant 820 feet. Thence still along north side of Maawaa stream to point bearing S 50° 06' W distant 400 feet. Thence along north side of Maawaa stream to point bearing S 56° 16' W distant 620 feet. Thence along N side of Maawaa stream to point bearing S 51° 16' W distant 1400 feet to junction with branch stream

near place called Nakama. S. 82° 25' N 1855 feet to top of a hill in woods
 called Ohau at the head of Government land. Thence N 15° 20' N
 1945 feet along stream called Maiau, said to be branch of
 Umuaima stream. S. 80° 25' N 11200 feet along land of Umuaima

 to upper edge of forest at an alupohaka and marked rock H 112

To Have and to Hold the above granted Land in Fee Simple, unto the said

W. K. Kawonani *For* Heirs and Assigns forever,

subject to the taxes to be from time to time imposed by the Legislative Council, equally upon all Landed Property held in Fee Simple.
