Land on the Northeast side of Ululani Street

Punahoa 1st, Hilo, Hawaii

Being a portion of R.P. 152, L.C.A. 2228 to Kaapa

Beginning at a pipe at the South corner of this piece and on the Northeast side of Ululani Street (Pleasant St.) the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Gov't Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 1857.86 feet North and 2883.67 feet East, and running by true azimuths:-

- 1. 153° 12' 147.00 feet along fence along the Northeast side of Ululani Street (Pleasant St.) to a pipe;
- 2. 238° 23' 233.76 feet along fence along Haili Church Lot to
- 3. 324° 25' 65.90 feet along fence to a pipe;
- 4. 60° 00' 24.08 feet along land owned by W.S. Wise to a pipe;
- 5. 331° 30' 102.65 feet along same to a pipe;
- 6. 63° 50' 222.03 feet along fence to the point of beginning.
