Portion of R.P. L.C.A. 2276 to Kuhio

Waianuenue Street, Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a $\frac{3}{8}$ inch iron pipe at the North corner of this lot on the Southeast side of Waianuenue Street from which the true azimuth and distance to an iron pipe at the West corner of the land described in Court of Land Registration Petition No. 82 is $236^{\circ} 48' 70.6$ feet, and the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig Station "Halei" are 2417.50 feet North and 1553.35 feet East, and running by true azimuths -

1. $326^{\circ} 41'$ 319.00 feet along fence to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron pipe at junction of stone walls.
2. $53^{\circ} 59'$ 146.95 feet along stone wall and fence to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron pipe at end of stone wall.
3. $141^{\circ} 02'$ 252.15 feet along fence to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron pipe,
4. $236^{\circ} 55'$ 37.70 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron pipe.
5. $146^{\circ} 18'$ 22.90 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron pipe;
6. $146^{\circ} 48'$ 55.90 feet to a ft in concrete on the Southeast side of Waianuenue Street.
7. $236^{\circ} 48'$ 183.95 feet along the Southeast side of Waianuenue Street to the point of beginning.
