Only upon written request from the applicant and for a good cause can a time extension be granted, provided it is submitted forty-five (45) days before the expiration of said period of one year.

The Planning Director shall confer with members of the Subdivision Technical Review Committee or other concerned agencies to resolve the problem and notify you accordingly.

No final approval for recordation shall be granted until all the above conditions have been met.

Land shall not be offered for sale, lease or rent until final approval for recordation of the subdivision.
