History: Created in ArcMap Version 9.3.1 by the County of Hawaii, Planning Department, 2011. The polygon data illustrates an approximate location of where a Land Commission Awards exists based on historical data. Historical data includes (but may not be limited to) surveyor notes, recorded or unrecorded documents of record, recorded maps or unrecorded maps of record, and archived plat map delineation.
