The 'Ohana Permits' data layer is parcel-specific when attempting to identify its' location. However, users should be aware that subsequent subdivision of parcels would change the tax map key numbers. Updates will occur to address this issue as time permits.

This data layer currently has over 4,000 records and many files were missing or unavailable during compilation. These records will be added as files become available.

Indication of a point data does not necessarily mean that an Ohana Dwelling physically exists on a parcel. Users are required to verify if an approved Ohana application actually received building permit approvals and that final inspection by the Dept. of Public Works, Building Division was made.
