Description: Identifies the boundaries of Special Design Districts for the purpose of routing certain Planning Department applications to the appropriate design review bodies. Specifically, the Kailua-Kona Village area, the Waimea Village area, the Pahoa Village area, and the Downtown Hilo area.

History: Created in ArcMap, version 10.3.1 by the County of Hawai‘i, Planning Department, 2018. Based on the previously existing layer for KVSD (Kailua Village Special District). Polygons were created by tracing TMK parcel boundary lines, as well as incorporating the existing polygon for KVSD, based on Hawai‘i County Code definitions and other authoritative documents.
