**DESCRIPTION**

Beginning at the East corner of this lot, marked by a + on stone, from which point to a + cut on the base of a Railroad concrete pier bears  $211^{\circ} 42' - 35.2$  feet, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Sta. "Haaheo", being North 4413.45 feet and West 622.60 feet and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $10^{\circ} 57'$  25.1 feet along Hawaii Consolidated Railway to an pin;
2.  $64^{\circ} 00'$  12.3 feet along L.C.A. 4972 Ap. 2 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " galv. iron pipe at the West corner of L.C.A. 4972;
3.  $334^{\circ} 00'$  16.3 feet along L.C.A. 4972 Ap. 2 to a + cut in cement walk;
4.  $10^{\circ} 57'$  19.5 feet to a stake;
5.  $89^{\circ} 18'$  65.0 feet to a stake;
6.  $190^{\circ} 57'$  65.0 feet to an iron pin in Maili Stream;
7.  $269^{\circ} 18'$  65.0 feet to the point of beginning and containing an area of 4040 Sq. Ft.
