- (f) The applicant shall conform to State Department of Health standards and regulations and following comment(s) dated August 19, 1991:

"Per Administrative Rule, Title 11, Chapter 62, Wastewater, prior to the approval of a septic tank system, plans and specifications of the individual wastewater system shall be designed by a professional engineer for review and acceptance by the Department of Health.

The Department of Health would like to inform the applicant that the wastewater rules is in the process of change and that comments made to the project may change accordingly."

(g) This Ohana Dwelling permit is subject to all other applicable rules, regulations and requirements, including but not limited to those of the Planning Department, Department of Public Works, and State Department of Health.
