Dear Mr. Ono:

The Planning and Traffic Commission, at its meeting held April 11, 1960, voted to grant you a variance to permit the killing and dressing of poultry at 545 Kaumana Drive, Hilo, Hawaii, as well as those raised by the applicant in the vicinity of Wainaku Camp 2. For this purpose, you may enlarge your existing plant in accordance with drawings on file with the Commission and subject to the following conditions:

1. The variance is granted for the period of its present lease to expire in 1972 or prior abandonment.
2. The disposal of waste be done in accordance with the regulations of the Department of Health.
3. The premises be kept at all times in a sanitary condition.

Cash amounting to \$74.80, balance of your \$100.00 deposit, is being returned.
