Dear Mr. Takara:

The Planning and Traffic Commission, at its meeting held August 15, 1960, voted to allow you a conditional use variance to process smoked pork only on a temporary basis on Lot 8, a portion of Grant 11757:2, situated at Piipohua Camp 3; subject, however, to the following conditions:

1. That the variance be granted for a period of two years or its prior abandonment,
2. That the operation be confined to smoked pork only,
3. That there be no expansion of the operation,
4. That there be no retailing of the products on the premises,
5. That not more than three employees be hired during the normal working hours,
6. That no advertising signs be erected on the premises.

A variance permit is being drafted for submission to the proper authorities, and a copy will be forwarded to you in the near future.
