## <u>VARIANCE</u> <u>PERMIT</u>

The County Planning Commission held a public hearing on August 26, 1966 on the application of FRANKLIN AHN for a variance from Section 21, Ordinance No. 23, County of Hawaii, to permit the construction of a radio tower and a 12 x 12 square foot building to house a transmitter for Radio Station KIMO in Keaukaha, South Hilo, Hawaii and covered by Tax Map Key: 2-1-15:01.

The Commission finds that the strict enforcement of Section 10 of Ordinance No. 23 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- 1. The subject area is mostly pond and could not yield a reasonable return if used only for the purpose allowed under the present zoning due to its watery topography.
- 2. General Plan indicates eventual agricultural designation for this area which permits the proposed use.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants a variance to the applicant pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 21 of the said Ordinance to allow the construction of a radio tower and a  $12 \times 12$  square foot building to house a transmitter, subject to the terms and conditions as stated below in order to protect the public interest and general welfare:

- 1. The proposed use shall conform to County building, and health standards, and FAA regulations.
- 2. Compliance with County subdivision standards as to lot size when subdivision of land is applied for.
- 3. Said construction of tower and transmitter building shall start within one year from the date of issuance of the variance permit or deem the variance null and void.
