<u>VARIANCE</u> <u>PERMIT</u>

The County Planning Commission held a public hearing on December 6, 1968, on the application of the Department of Transportation, State of Hawaii, for a variance from Section 21 of Ordinance 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967 as amended, more specifically, a variance from the minimum building site requirement of an MG-1 (General Industrial 1-acre) District to permit the construction of a cement storage plant at Kawaihae Harbor, Kawaihae, South Kohala, Hawaii, TMK: 6-1-03, on a lot containing 20,008 square feet.

The Commission finds that strict enforcement of Section 21 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- 1. There is definitely a limited amount of available land in the area adjacent to the wharf for industrial use.
- Location of site is ideal for proposed use; a more distant site would be inadequate.
- 3. Proposed use would not be detrimental to the County General Plan nor the public welfare.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant, a variance from the minimum building site requirement pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance on the condition that:

1. All other conditions of the Ordinance 63 shall prevail in the development of said property. Department of Transportation Page 2
