## VARIANCE PERMIT

The County Planning Commission held a public hearing on December 6, 1968, on the application of VALERIANO ABAD as initiated by the State of Hawaii for a variance from Section 13 of Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967 as amended, more specifically, a variance from setback requirements of an Agricultural District (A-la) on the corner of Kahili Street and the Honokaa-Waipio Road, TMK: 4-5-18:26, Honokaa, Hawaii.

The Commission finds that strict enforcement of Section 13 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- 1. Present lot size does not enable owner to meet proper setback requirements of Ordinance No. 63.
- 2. Present lot is non-conforming in area.
- Present lot size was created by condemnation for highway widening purposes.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the setback requirements of an Agricultural District (A-la) pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance on the condition that:

- 1. Existing structure be relocated no less than 5 feet from the north (Honokaa-Waipio Road) boundary and no less than 4 feet from east (town) boundary. All other boundaries shall conform to Ordinance 63 requirements.
- 2. This variance shall be in effect for 30 years from approval date or the removal, demolition or repair of the existing structure in excess of 25% per year, whichever shall first occur. Any enlargements, changes or additions shall be in full compliance with Ordinance 63.
