VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on September 18, 1969 on the application of ETHYL F. GREEN, owner, for a variance from Section 36, Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow the creation of 1) a smaller than 1-acre parcel in an A-la zone and 2) a lesser average width than is permissible, both on a 2.9 parcel located in Pahoa about 1 mile makai of the School and 800 feet from the Kaniahiku Village Road entrance along the main Government Road, tax map key 1-5-03:1.

The Commission finds that strict enforcement of Section 36 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- 1. Present shape of the lot and the siting of the existing dwelling renders difficulty in proportioning the parcel otherwise.
- 2. Present zoning of A-la only permits 1-acre lots to be created but the .1 acre deficiency requested is reasonable and would not adversely affect the General Plan.
- 3. Although granting of the request would create a smaller than allowable 1-acre lot, the proposed lot and the proposed average width would not constitute special privilege.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the Ordinance requirement pertaining to lot size and average width pursuant to the authority vested in by Section 36 of said Ordinance on' the condition that:

- 1. Proposed subdivision follows plat dated July 29, 1969, submitted with application.
- 2. Pole of the flag lot thus created shall be paved.
- 3. All other aspects of the Subdivision Ordinance and Ordinance 63 shall be complied with.
