VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on November 20, 1969 on the application of Hawaiian Telephone Company for a variance from Section 36, Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow a lesser front or rear setback for a telephone equipment room addition in Manowaiopae Homesteads, North Hilo, Hawaii, covered by Tax Map Key 3-6-09:36.

The Commission finds that strict enforcement of Section 36 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- Building is on an extremely small (2,633 square feet) existing lot.
- 2. Triangular shaped lot is bordered on its two long axes by Belt Highway and Mamalahoa Highway--cannot be enlarged.
- 3. Use is a needed utility structure (telephone) addition vital for communications along coastline.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the Ordinance pertaining to yard requirement pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance on the condition that:

- 1. The entire telephone equipment building will be removed by December 31, 1974 by the Hawaiian Telephone Company.
 - Conformance with all other pertinent regulations of the County, the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance and including Plan Approval.
 - 3. Construction to begin within one year of this variance approval date.
