Application for VARIANCE by STATE OF HAWAII from MINIMUM BUILDING SITE AREA REQUIREMENT in OLAA, PUNA, HAWAII

VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on February 19, 1970 on the application of State of Hawaii for a variance from Section 13, Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow a variance from the minimum building site area along both sides of the Volcano Road, Tax Map Key 1-8-Portions of Plats 03, 04, & 05.

The Commission finds that strict enforcement of Section 13 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- The small lots are to be acquired and kept by the State 1. as scenic easements and that no buildings will be allowed.
- It is in line with the intent of the General Plan to 2. create scenic borders.
- There is no conflict with the intent of the State 3. Land Use law nor the General Plan.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the minimum building site area pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance.
