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Application for VARIANCE by KANJI NAGAO from MINIMUM BUILDING SETBACK REQUIREMENT in KAUMANA, SOUTH HILO

Variance No. 193

VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on February 19, 1970 on the application of Kanji Nagao for a variance from Section 9, Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow a variance from the minimum building setback requirement, TMK: 2-5-04:22, 72, 79 and Portion of 71.

The Commission finds that strict enforcement of Section 9 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- 1. It would not militate against the intent of the General Plan.
- 2. It would not materially change the neighborhood characteristic. It would in fact improve the existing condition.
- 3. It is not a special privilege which others similarly situated could not obtain.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the minimum building setback requirement pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance on the condition that:

1. All other pertinent County of Hawaii ordinances are complied with.
