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Application for VARIANCE by STANLEY N. NAGATA from MINIMUM REAR SETBACK REQUIREMENT in KEOPUKA, S. KONA

Variance No. 195

VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on February 19, 1970 on the application of Stanley N. Nagata for a variance from Section 9, Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow a variance from the rear setback requirement, Tax Map Key 8-1-15:11.

The Commission finds that strict enforcement of Section 9 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- 1. The hardship is evident due to the terrain.
- 2. Moving the dwelling would be a huge cost.
- 3. The staff believes that this was an unintentional error since the applicant is building his own home.
- 4. It would still be in accord with sound land use practice.
- 5. It is not a special privilege which others similarly situated could not obtain.
- 6. No oppositions have been received from the surrounding property owners.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the minimum rear setback requirement pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance on the condition that:

- 1. There would be completion within one year of the granting of this variance.
- 2. Conformance with all regulations.
