## VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on May 14, 1970 on the application of Puna Sugar Company, Ltd., for a variance from Sections 13 and 30, Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow a variance from the height and distance between buildings requirement for the construction of a proposed diffusion plant and a steam and power generating plant in Keaau, Puna, Hawaii, covered by Tax Map Key 1-6-03:5.

The Commission finds that strict enforcement of Sections 13 and 30 would involve practical difficulty and unnecessary hardship for the following reasons:

- 1. That there are special circumstances applying to this variance to the height requirement inasmuch as a variance for height on the steam plant, previously granted, is higher than the present request.
- That the multi-cyclone dust collection system installed in the boiler system has been endorsed by the State Department of Health.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the height and distance between buildings requirement pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance on the condition that:

- sl. That development be substantially as shown on plans submitted to the Planning Department.
  - 2. That construction of development start within one year of this date or the variance be deemed null and void.
