VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on June 18, 1970 on the application of Akona Kona, Inc. for a variance from Section 30-F-4, Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow a variance from the minimum number of required parking stalls for the proposed Akona-Kai Mall development, Tax Map Key 7-5-06:25 and 28.

The Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the minimum number of required parking stalls pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance on the condition that:

- 1. Extensive landscaping be done in the front so as to keep the entrance in an attractive setting. Nonconformance of this requirement would void this variance.
- 2. The construction conform substantially to the drawings as submitted to the Planning Department - the front setback shall remain as shown on plans so as to have adequate room to provide additional parking when required.
- 3. The construction of buildings begin within one year of the date of approval or the variance shall be deemed null and void.
- 4. The building is not to exceed two stories in height.
