VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission held a public hearing on September 16, 1971 on the application of HIROSHI SHIMABUKURO for a variance from Section 9-D, Ordinance No. 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow the creation of a 9,395 square foot lot within a Single-Family Residential 10,000 square foot Minimum Lot Size Zone (RS-10) to be located in the Manowaiopae Homesteads Area, North Hilo, Hawaii, Tax Map Key 3-6-9:16, 17, and 18.

The Commission finds that:

- 1. Unusual circumstances exist in that the boundary pins were erroneously placed thus resulting in the dwelling being erroneously set back.
- 2. The granting of the variance would neither be substantially injurious to property rights related to properties in the near vicinity nor be contrary to the public interest.
- 3. The granting of the variance will neither substantially alter the essential character of the land nor affect its present use.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance from the Minimum Lot Size Requirement within a Single-Family Residential - 10,000 square foot zone (RS-10) pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance on the condition that all other applicable regulations shall be complied with.
