VARIANCE PERMIT

The Planning Commission at a duly held public hearing on December 14, 1972, considered the application of ALEXANDER CARVALHO, for a variance from Section 9-F(2), Ordinance 63 of the Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, more specifically, to allow the construction of a workshop/shed with a side yard building setback of five (5) feet in lieu of the required ten (10) feet setback as prescribed by the single-family residential (RS-15) zoned district. The subject structure is located in the Piihonua Houselots, Piihonua, South Hilo, Hawaii,

The Commission has found that:

- 1. The subject building replaced an existing building;
- Unreasonable hardship would occur if the building was required to be relocated to meet the required side setback; and
- 3. No objection was presented by the adjoining neighbor whose dwelling faces the subject structure.

Therefore, the Commission hereby grants to the applicant a variance to allow the construction of a workshop/shed with a side yard building setback of five (5) feet in lieu of the required ten (10) feet setback as prescribed by the single-family residential (RS-15) zoned district pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 36 of said Ordinance.

The effective date of this permit shall be from December 14, 1972.
