1. 9°03'30" 616.00 feet along Government land to a pipe;
2. 30°00'30" 589.00 feet along Government land to a pipe;
3. 138°10' 450.00 feet along Government land to a pipe;
4. 210°00' 1035.70 feet along Government land to a pipe;
5. 309°40' 1092.00 feet along the South Side of Old Volcano Road to a pipe;
6. 296°12' 100.00 feet along the South Side of Old Volcano Road to the point of beginning and containing an area of 9.286 Acres.
