AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.04, THE KAILUA URBAN ZONE MAP, ORDINANCE NO. 63 (ZONING ORDINANCE), REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE COUNTY OF HAWAII 1967, AS AMENDED, BY CHANGING THE DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION FROM MULTIPLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL, 1,000 SQUARE FEET OF LAND AREA PER RENTABLE UNIT (RM-1) TO RESORT-HOTEL 750 SQUARE FEET OF LAND AREA PER RENTABLE UNIT (VH-.75) FOR A PARCEL IN PUAA 3rd, NORTH KONA, HAWAII, COVERED BY TAX MAP KEY 7-5-09:34.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 7.04 of Ordinance No. 63 (Zoning Ordinance), Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

"7.04(c). The district classification of the following area situated at Puaa 3rd, North Kona, Hawaii, shall be Resort-Hotel, 750 square feet of land area per rentable unit (VH-.75):

Beginning at a spike in concrete at the northwest corner of this parcel of land, the coordinates of which referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "KAILUA" being 4045.84 feet south and 1893.70 feet east, and thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from true south:

- 5. 160° 21' 101.27 feet along the easterly side of Alii Drive to the point of beginning and containing an area of 12,495 square feet.




