AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.02, THE NORTH KONA ZONE MAP, ORDINANCE NO. 63 (ZONING ORDINANCE), REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE COUNTY OF HAWAII 1967, AS AMENDED, BY CHANGING THE DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION FROM AGRICULTURAL (A-la) IN KALOKO, NORTH KONA, HAWAII COVERED BY TAX MAP KEY 7-3-09:10 AND 12.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 7.02 of Ordinance No. 63 (Zoning Ordinance), Revised Ordinances of the County of Hawaii 1967, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

"7.02 (v). The district classification of the following area situated at Kaloko, North Kona, Hawaii, shall be Agricultural (A-1a):

Beginning at a point at the northeast corner of this parcel of land, and on the westerly side of Kohanaiki Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "MOANUIAHEA," being 13,096.55 feet South and 10,304.32 feet West, and thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:

"All as outlined in red on the map attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and by reference made a part hereof."

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this ordinance shall take effect forthwith upon the conditions that (A) the area be zoned in three (3) increments. The first and second increments shall each consist of forty (40) lots and the third shall consist of the remaining lots. The effective date of zoning for the second increment shall be after development has occurred on the first increment. Development is defined as building permits issued for residential dwelling units and construction partially completed - partially completed in the sense of having roofs on those units - on ten (10) or twenty-five (25) per cent of the lots in the first increment. The effective date of zoning for the third increment shall be after development has occurred on thirty (30) of the eighty (80) lots of the previous increments. This is to assure that a minimum of twenty-five (25) per cent of the lots of the entire requested area would have dwellings on them; and (B) the owner or lessee of the subject area submit a subdivision plan and secure preliminary approval of the first increment no later than one year from the date of approval of the change of zone request. Should this condition not be met, the Planning Commission shall reserve the right to initiate action to rezone the subject area to its former designation.

SECTION 3. In the event that any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other parts of the ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.






